






When Jesus comes into your life, your daily routine may not change much but your PRIORITIES do.

"At the hour of prayer",


"Peter saw his opportunity"

"expecting to receive something from them"




What is the "Good News"? It's both information AND action.

the hand"




A genuinely changed life draws the attention of others.
