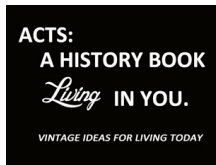
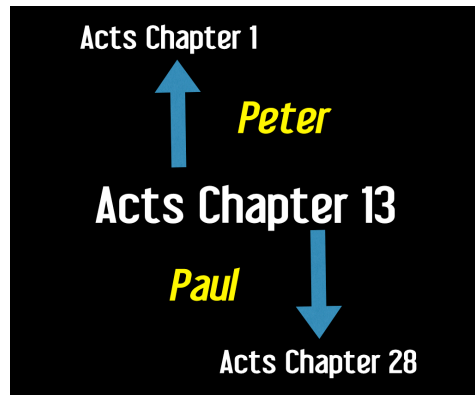


Worth Dying (and Living) For.

Acts: Part 16 (Acts 13:1-3 & 38-39) Noah Largent 5/4/14



Acts 13:1-3 & 38-39 Now there were these prophets and teachers in the church at Antioch: Barnabas, Simeon called Niger, Lucius the Cyrenian, Manaen (a close friend of Herod the tetrarch from childhood) and Saul. ²While they were serving the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said, "Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them." ³Then, after they had fasted and prayed and placed their hands on them, they sent them off. ³⁸Therefore let it be known to you, brothers, that through this one forgiveness of sins is proclaimed to you, ³⁹and by this one everyone who believes is justified from everything from which the law of Moses could not justify you. The legend of Nachshon:

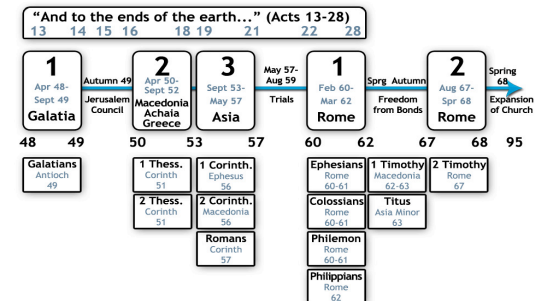
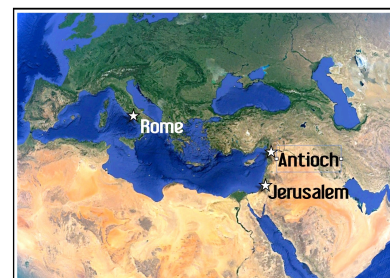
2. If you want to experience God working in your life, you've got to **pursue Him!**
