## FOOL PROOF: WISDOM IN PROVERBS: PART#4 NOAH LARGENT 9/21/14



**Proverbs 1:2&3** for attaining wisdom and **discipline**; for understanding words of insight. For acquiring a **disciplined** and prudent life, doing what is right and just and fair.

- **1:7** The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge, but fools despise wisdom and **discipline**.
- **3:11&12** My son, do not despise the LORD'S **discipline** and do not resent his rebuke, because the LORD **disciplines** those he loves, as a father the son he delights in.
- **5:12 Y**ou will say, "How I hated **discipline**! How my heart spurned correction!
- **5:23** He will die for lack of **discipline**, led astray by his own great folly.
- **6:23** For these commands are a lamp, this teaching is a light, and the corrections of **discipline** are the way to life,
- **10:17** He who heeds **discipline** shows the way, but whoever ignores correction leads others astray.
- **12:1** Whoever loves **discipline** loves knowledge, but he who hates correction is stupid.
- **13:18** He who ignores **discipline** comes to poverty and shame, but whoever heeds correction is honored.
- **13:24** He who spares the rod hates his son, but he who loves him is careful to **discipline** him.
- **15:5** A fool spurns his father's **discipline**, but whoever heeds correction shows prudence.
- **15:10** Stern **discipline** awaits him who leaves the path; he who hates correction will die.
- **15:32** He who ignores **discipline** despises himself, but whoever heeds correction gains understanding.
- **19:18 Discipline** your son, for in that there is hope; do not be a willing party to his death.
- **22:15** Folly is bound up in the heart of a child, but the rod of **discipline** will drive it far from him.
- **23:13** Do not withhold **discipline** from a child; if you punish him with the rod, he will not die.
- 23:23 Buy the truth and do not sell it; get wisdom, discipline and understanding.
- **29:17 Discipline** your son, and he will give you peace; he will bring delight to your soul.

Hebrew: מוּקר "musar"

- **1. Discipline/Instruction:** Learning from a coach.
- **2. Discipline:** Consequences for the purpose of correction.
- **3. Discipline:** Exercising self-control.
