

-156 time in New Testament (13 X in Ephesians)


Old Testament: "hesed"

That which confers joy or pleasure. God's covenant love. Kindness.

-248 time in Old Testament

verse 4: he chose us in him before the creation of the world.


verse 5: predestined us for adoption


verse 5-6: in accordance with *his pleasure* and will—6 to the praise of his glorious grace, which he has *freely given us* in the One he loves.
