



1. "what is old has passed away" This is aorist tense in the indicative mood referring to a completed act in past time.



<u>2 Corinthians 5:18</u> all these things are from God who reconciled us to himself through Christ

Ephesians 2:12-13 remember that you were at that time separated from Christ, alienated... having no hope and without God. ¹³ But now in Christ Jesus you who used to be far away have been brought near by the blood of Christ.

MUDAHERANWA: "I burned her house. I attacked her in order to kill her and her children, but God protected them, and they escaped. When I was released from jail, if I saw her, I would run and hide. Then a group provided us with trainings. To have good relationships with the person to whom you did evil deeds — I decided to ask her for forgiveness. We thank God."

MUKANYANDWI: "I used to hate him. When he came to my house and knelt down before me and asked for forgiveness, I was moved by his sincerity. Now, if I cry for help, he comes to rescue me. When I face any issue, I call him."

Their story is not an uncommon one.

Today many of these people worship side by side in their village churches.
