1. How do you speak to your friends about your spouse?

5:7 The watchmen found me as they made their rounds in the city. They beat me, they bruised me; they took away my cloak.

5:16 This is my beloved! This is my companion, O maidens of Jerusalem!

<u>Ephesians 4:29</u> Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen.

<u>James 3:9&10</u> With the tongue we praise our Lord and Father, and with it we curse human beings, who have been made in God's likeness. 10 Out of the same mouth come praise and cursing. My brothers and sisters, this should not be.
