


UNCOVERING THE REAL JESUS IN THE BOOK OF JOHN


John 1:14-18

3. Do you believe that God still wants to "live with us"?

Jesus promised his friends that although he was leaving, he would send the Holy Spirit to be with them. (John 14:16-17 I will ask the Father, and he will give you another advocate to help you and be with you forever—17 the Spirit of truth.... you know him, for **he lives** with you and will bein you.) You don't have to find a special place to be near God. You don't have to "get it all together" to experience the presence of God's Spirits in you. The experience begins (and continues) when we confess to God that we don't want to live life for ourselves or according to our own desires. What we most want is Him and his loving leadership.
