Proverbs 1:1–7,22&30–32 The proverbs of Solomon son of David, king of Israel: <sup>2</sup> for gaining wisdom and instruction; for understanding words of insight; <sup>3</sup> for receiving instruction in prudent behavior, doing what is right and just and fair; <sup>4</sup> for giving prudence to those who are simple, <sup>4</sup> knowledge and discretion to the young—<sup>5</sup> let the wise listen and add to their learning, and let the discerning get guidance—<sup>6</sup> for understanding proverbs and parables, the sayings and riddles of the wise. <sup>7</sup> *The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge, but fools despise wisdom and instruction.* <sup>22</sup> "How long will you who are simple love your simple ways? How long will mockers delight in mockery and fools hate knowledge? <sup>30</sup> Since they would not accept my advice and spurned my rebuke, <sup>31</sup> they will eat the fruit of their ways and be filled with the fruit of their schemes. <sup>32</sup> For the waywardness of the simple will kill them, & the complacency of fools will destroy them.

- 1. Someone who ignores the order (laws) God has put in place **BUT** should know better.
- 2. Someone who ignores how sin has corrupted the world.

## THE FOOL WHO CAN'T CONTROL THEIR MOUTH...

Prov. 10:8 The wise in heart accept commands, but <u>a chattering</u> <u>fool</u> comes to ruin. Prov. 10:10, 14 & 18

#### THE ARROGANT FOOL ...

Prov. 26:12 Do you see a man <u>wise in his own eyes</u>? There is more hope for a <u>fool</u> than for him. Prov. 12:15, 15:5, 18:2 & 28:26

#### THE ANGRY FOOL ...

Prov. 14:16-17 The wise fear the Lord & shun evil, but <u>a</u> fool is hotheaded & yet feels secure. <sup>17</sup> A quick-tempered person does foolish things. Prov. 20:3 & 29:11

#### THE MALICIOUS FOOL ...

Prov. 10:23 <u>A fool finds pleasure in evil conduct</u>, but a man of understanding delights in wisdom. Prov. 4:14-17

## THE FOOL FOR CHRIST...

1Cor. 3:18 Do not deceive yourselves. If any of you think you are wise by the standards of this age, **you should become "fools"** so that you may become wise.

Matthew 7:24-27 "Therefore everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on the rock. <sup>25</sup> The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house; yet it did not fall, because it had its foundation on the rock. <sup>26</sup> But everyone who hears these words of mine and does not put them into practice is like a foolish man who built his house on sand. <sup>27</sup> The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and blew and beat against that house, and it fell with a great crash."
