#### 1. Sex difference is central to how the Bible talks about marriage.

Genesis 2:22-24 Then the Lord God made a <u>woman</u> from the rib he had taken out of the <u>man</u>, and he brought her to the man. <sup>23</sup> The man said.... That is why a man leaves his father and mother and is united to his wife, and they become one flesh.

Matthew 19:4-6 (Mark 10:2-9) "Haven't you read," he replied, "that at the beginning the Creator 'made them male and female,' <sup>5</sup> and said, 'For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be united to his wife, and the two will become one flesh'? <sup>6</sup> So they are no longer two, but one flesh. <u>Sex outside of marriage (one man/one woman):</u> Abraham - Sarah/Hagar (Genesis 16), <u>Lot</u> - incest (Genesis 19), <u>Adultery</u> - (Exodus 20:14, Hosea, David, Proverbs 6:32, John 4, 1 Corinthians 6:18 and Hebrews 13:4).
